### Dr. Mel Levine Director, Bringing Up Minds

Dr. Mel Levine will present an approach to learning disorders that is highly specific in pinpointing where the breakdown is occurring when a student struggles with a particular aspect of academic performance. He will focus on critical phenomena that are not captured on tests but are evident when a parent, teacher, or clinician knows what he or she is looking for! These will include a range of organizational deficiencies, difficulties with recurrent pattern recognition, insidious memory dysfunctions, and festering language shortfalls. Dr Levine will describe practical tactics for classroom and home management that emerge from detection of these phenomena. He will also talk about the critical importance of “diagnosing,” “treating,” and utilizing fully a child’s underlying strengths and affinities.
