



Summer Adventures in Learning 2010

SAIL features classes designed to enable students with learning difficulties ages 6 – 14, to succeed and maintain their academic skills during the summer months. The classes are offered in a small relaxed environment, taught by teachers trained in learning disabilities. A strong emphasis is placed on individual learning styles and independence.

Choose 3, 4 or 7 classes from the list below. All classes will be scheduled back to back.

- Reading:** Students will be taught using the Orton Gillingham/Wilson Reading Program utilizing a multi-sensory, phonetically based, structured, and sequential language approach to better enable students to become fluent, independent readers.
- Math:** Students will use multi-sensory approaches to develop their math skills and will learn how to apply and utilize these approaches in the math process.
- Study Skills/Writing Strategies:** Students will better understand how they think and learn by exploring different organizational strategies and note taking methods. Written language skills will be developed.
- Computers:** Students will learn computer skills using educational programs. A variety of skills will be developed through various programs: Microsoft templates, Excel, and PowerPoint.
- Social Awareness:** Students will learn and develop skills to better interact with their peers. Personal strengths and weaknesses will be explored, emphasizing strengths.
- Art:** Students will develop their creative expression through multi-sensory, hands-on art projects.
- Music:** Students will enjoy and discover different types of music and musical notation focusing on rhythm and movement.
